Cookies placed by Google Analytics	This helps us understand how you use the Website and helps us to improve your experience. These cookies may track how long you spend on the Website and the pages you visit.	The retention period will be between 90 days and 2 years depending on the type of cookie used.	<a href="#">Google Analytics</a>
Cookies placed by Vimeo	The video players you see on our Website are powered by Vimeo, these cookies enable to Vimeo video players to operate.	Cookies may be either "session" or "persistent." A session cookie expires (i.e., is deleted) when you close your browser. A persistent cookie remains until it expires or you delete the cookies via your browser settings. Expiration dates are set in the cookies themselves and may vary in length, depending on the purpose of the cookie.	<a href="#">Vimeo</a>

You can disable cookies by activating the setting on your browser that allows you to refuse the setting of all or some cookies. However, if you use your browser settings to block all cookies (including essential cookies) you may not be able to access all or parts of our Website.
